
Washington High School will hold a faculty meeting to discuss end of our year and upcoming 2023 objectives for our campus. I will be meeting with the department heads

New - - In Building Staffing & Postings- SBCSC HR

At this time, all open positions are posted on the school corporation's website. The posting/interview period will take place from Monday, March 14th through Wednesday, March 23th. New positions will be posted throughout this timeframe as they become available. **Candidates should check the website daily for updates.**

All candidates that are awarded a position will be notified at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 24th. Candidates will then have 24 hours to respond with a confirmation of acceptance or rejection of the position. If a candidate has multiple offers, they will still only have 24 hours to make their decision. Once a position is accepted, it **cannot be retracted** for a different position. All accepted or rejected decisions must be completed on the position offer form that the principal will be emailing that morning. No positions will be offered earlier than 9:00 a.m. Thursday, March 24.

Teachers who are displaced and are not awarded a position, will be placed in the displacement pool. The tentative displacement pool draft date is Wednesday, April 13th. Final confirmation will be communicated directly to those in the displacement pool once the list is finalized.

Mr. Hammond says looking back at his youth and the way he thought about himself and where he is today, combined with the work he did in mental health, gives him a wider perspective on the students we work with.


